

## Present your findings of how modern China is a reflection of ancient China

Your presentation should consist of no more than 8 slides. You should have;

1. **an introduction slide**
2. **3-6 slides proving your point (you must have a minimum of 3 comparison topics**

**Possible ideas (philosophies vs religion - dam vs Great Wall)**

3. **1 conclusion slide**

This presentation should be done on slides. You can use conventional power point or try a new 2.0 tool [rocketslide.com](http://rocketslide.com) or [presentit.com](http://presentit.com) (you might want to challenge yourself and use something new - you will need to set up a new account if you use one of these) The 2.0 tools are more flexible and often you can add video.-Would you ever think of making a video? How creative are you? If you need help with sound or video just ask or find a team mate that did it in their glog.
